- Why Need is documented and lack of funds to address the need is well documented; creative approaches are essential as public funds are not likely to increase; can coordinate well with Affordable Heat proposal recently funded by Maine Technology Institute (Jon Calame, Thermal Efficiency Eastport and partners)?
- How 3 hour meeting with background information on financial margins to achieve objectives, examples of similar successful examples?
